*Artomyces pyxidatus* - Crown Coral; formerly *Clavicornia pyxidata*  
*Arcyria denudate* - Pink Cotton Candy Slime Mold  
*Auricularia auricular* – Tree Ear  
*Bisporella citrine* - Lemon Drops  
*Coprinus radians* - fruiting from orange mycelial mat (ozonium)  
*Coprinus variegatus* - Shingle Cap Inky, formerly *Coprinus quadrifidus*  
*Cordyceps militaris*  
*Crepidotus spp.* - like little oyster mushrooms with brown spores  
*Ductifera pululahuana* - White Jelly, formerly *Exidia alba*  
*Galiella rufa* - Rubber Cup  
*Ganoderma applanatum* - Artist's Conk  
*Geastrum sp.* - Earth Star, old, from last year  
*Gymnopus dryophilus* - Oak Collybia  
*Hemitrichia sp.* - Stalked Cup Slime Mold  
*Hymenopellis megalospora* – Formerly known as *Xerula megalospora*  
*Hypoxyylon sp.* - Black Crust  
*Irpex lacteus* - Milk Tooth  
*Lycogala exiguum* - Pepto-Bismol Slime Mold or Wolf's Milk  
*Marasmius capillaris* grows on leaf litter  
*Megacollybia platyphylla* – Platterful Collybia  
*Microstoma floccosum* - Fairy Goblets  
*Mycena sp.*  
*Mycena leaiana* – Orange Mycena  
*Pholiota sp.* Possibly *granulose* - shaggy cap margin, on wood  
*Pluteus admirabilis* - Yellow Pluteus  
*Pluteus cervinus* - Deer Mushroom  
*Polyporus alveolaris* - Hickory Stick Polypore (orange with hexagonal pores)  
*Polyporus elegans* - Elegant Polypore or Little Black Foot with smooth pileus/cap  
*Polyporus squamosus* – Dryad's Saddle or Pheasant Back  
*Polyporus varius* - Little Black Foot with radial fibers on pileus/cap and larger than *P. elegans*  
*Sarcoscypha austriaca* - Early Spring Scarlet Cup  
*Sarcoscypha occidentalis* - Little Red Cup  
*Schizophyllum commune* - Split Gill  
*Scutellinia scutellata* - Eyelash Cup (red, on wood)

*Stemonitus axifera* – Chocolate Tube Slime Mold

*Stereum complicatum*

*Stereum ostrea* - Log Leaves (smooth hymenium/underside)

*Tranetes pubescens*

*Trichaptum bifforme* - Purple Tooth

*Tremella mesenterica* – Witches Butter

*Xerula megalaspora*

*Xylaria* sp. - Dead Man's Fingers; white tips exhibit asexual  
conidiospores
