<i>Crucibulum laeve</i>	Bird Nest Fungus, White-egg Bird Nest
<i>Daedaleopsis confragosa</i>	Thin-walled Maze Polypore
<i>Daldinia concentrica</i>	Carbon Ball
<i>Ductifera pululahuana</i>	Exida alba, White jelly

<i>Lactarius cf. oculatus</i>	Orange with pointed unbo
<i>Lactarius subplinthogalus</i>	Distant gill, stains salmon
<i>Leotia lubrica</i>	Jelly Baby
<i>Lepiota americana</i>	Bruises yellow then turns red
<i>Marasmiellus nigripes</i>	Black Footed Marasmius
<i>Marasmius siccus</i>	Brick Top, Orange Pinwheel Marasmius
<i>Mycena haematopus</i>	Bleeding Mycena
<i>Mycena leaiana</i>	Orange Mycena
<i>Mycena luteopalens</i>	Walnut Mycena

<i>Phellinus gilvus</i>	Tiger Eye
<i>Phleogena faginea</i>	False Slime Jelly; Looks like a slime mold but has septate basidia bearing four sessile spores, hyphae with clamp connections, smooth globose spores
<i>Pluteus lutescens</i>	Yellow-stemmed Pluteus, Brown Cap
<i>Pluteus admirabilis</i>	Yellow Pluteus
<i>Pluteus cervinus</i>	Deer Mushroom, Fawn Mushroom
<i>Polycephalomyces tomentosus</i>	<i>Hyphomycete</i> growing on <i>Metatrachia vesparium</i>
<i>Polyporus badius</i>	Big Black Foot, <i>Royoporus badius</i>
<i>Polyporus elegans</i>	Little Black Foot
<i>Polyporus varius</i>	Little Black Foot, Radial fibers on pileus
<i>Rhodotus palmatus</i>	Netted Rhodotus
