Agaricus sp.

Aleurodiscus oakesii – Oak Bark Eater

Armillaria cf. *gallica* – Honey Mushroom

Bjerkandera adusta – Smoky Polypore (gray to blackish minute pores)

Calvatia sp. – Giant Puffball (lacking apical pore)

Cerrena unicolor – Mossy Polypore (gray maze-like pores)

Daedalea quercina – Oak Maze Polypore (pores with very thick dissepiments/walls)

Daldinia concentrica – Carbon Balls (interior with concentric zones)

Discomycetes – Cup Fungi (Ascomycetes)

Aleuria sp. – Orange Cups

Ascocoryne sp. – Purple Cups

Bisporella citrina – Yellow Cups

Scutellinia sp. – Red Eyelash Cups

Ganoderma applanatum – Artist's Conk

Ganoderma lucidum – Lacquered Artist's Conk

Gloeoporus dichrous

Grifola frondosa – Hen-of-the Woods, Goat's Beard

Hypsizygus ulmarius – Knothole Oyster

Irpex lacteus – Milk Tooth

Ischnoderma resinosum – Thin Skin Resin Polypore

Laetiporus cincinnatus – White-pored Chicken-of-the-Woods, Sulphur Shelf

Lycogala epidendrum – (myxomycete) Pepto-Bismol Slime, Wolf's Milk Slime

Lycoperdon pyriforme – Pear-shaped Puffball (with apical pore)

Mycena spp.

Phlebia tremellosa – *Merulius tremellosus* (wrinkled pore surface)

Phellinus gilvus

Phellinus cf. *everhartii*

Pholiota cf. *aurivella* – Scaly *Pholiota*

Pleurotus ostreatus – Oyster Mushroom

Pleurotus sapidus – Brown Oyster Mushroom (synonymous with *P. ostreatus*)

Polyporus squamosus – Pheasant Back, Dryad's Saddle

Psathyrella cf. *echiniceps* – Weeping Widow

Rhodotus palmatus – net-like ridges on cap surface

Schizophyllum commune – Split Gill

Scleroderma sp. – Earthball

Stereum complicatum – Orange Logs Leaves

Stereum ostrea – False Turkey Tail, Common Log Leaves (smooth underside)

Trametes elegans – *Daedaleopsis ambigua*, Ambiguous Polypore (glancing pores)

Trametes versicolor – Turkey Tail (minute white to dingy yellow pores)

Trichaptum bifforme – Purple Tooth
