List of fungi compiled by Dean Abel and Damian Pieper
(Fungi do not have “official” common names so many of these are invented.)

Auricularia auricular – Jelly Ears or Tree Ears
Boletus pulverulentus – dark brown cap, pores rather than gills, cut flesh immediately stains deep blue, base of stem exhibits flash of red then bluing
Cotylidia diaphana – Fairy Tutu or Stalked Stereum; collected by Russ Benedict
Cyathus striatus – Striated Bird’s Nest Fungus
Ductifera pululahuana – White Jelly; formerly *Exidia alba*
Ganoderma applanatum – Artist’s Conk
Inocybe sp. – Fiber Head
Lactarius subserifluus – Orange Milky Cap; scanty latex, orange strands at base of stem
Marasmius rotula – Pinwheel Mushroom; gills attached to collar at top of stem
Panellus stipticus – Luminescent Mushroom; gills glow in the dark
Polyporus alveolaris – Orange Honeycomb Mushroom with hexagonal pores
Polyporus elegans – Little Black Foot with smooth cap
Polyporus varius – Little Black Foot with radial fibers on cap
Rhodotus palmatus – Pink Net Cap
Russula spp. – several species of Crumble Caps
Sarcoscypha occidentalis – Little Red Cups on sticks
Schizophyllum commune – Split Gill
Scleroderma areolatum – Scaly Earthball
Sebacina incrustans – encrusting stems and leaves
Stereum complicatum – Orange Parchment
Ustilina deusta – Carbon Cushion
Xerula megalospora – Rooting *Collybia* with smooth stipe; formerly *Collybia radicata*
