*Boletus* sp. (KOH on flesh produced flash of magenta turning blue gray)  
*Calvatia gigantea* (Giant Puffball; extralimital)  
*Clitopilus prunulus* (Sweetbread Mushroom; pink spores)  
*Crinula caliciiformis* (imperfect form of *Holwaya mucida*)  
*Daldinia concentrica* (Carbon Balls)  
*Entoloma abortivum* (Marshmallow Mushroom; parasitic on Honey Mushrooms)  
*Galerina marginata* (= *G. autumnalis*; POISONOUS Little Brown Mushroom)  
*Ganoderma applanatum* (Artist's Conk)  
*Ganoderma lucidum* (Varnished Polypore; Reishi or Ling Zhi)  
*Gloeoporus dichrous* (Rubber Band Polypore; elastic pore layer)  
*Grifola frondosa* (Hen-of-the Woods)  
*Hericium erinaceus* (Lion's Mane, Satyr's Beard)  
*Hyphomyces* sp. (imperfect fungus on dung)  
*Hypsizygus ulmarius* (Knothole Oyster; *H. ulmarius* certainly must hold the record for being the most often misnamed mushroom in America. While it was formerly known as *Pleurotus ulmarius*, the most common error has been to use the name *H. tessulatus*. A report by Scott Redhead in *Mycologia* (1986) indicates that *H. tessellatus* is a smaller mushroom which grows in clusters, and is widely cultivated in Japan as hon-shimeji. – MushroomExpert.com)

*Lycoperdon* sp. (Puffballs)  
*Mycena luteopallens* (Nut *Mycena*)  
*Naematoloma sublateritium* (Brick Tops)  
*Phallus ravenelii* (stinkhorn)  
*Phellinus gilvus* (Tiger Eye Polypore; orange trama)  
*Pleurotus ostreatus* (Oyster Mushroom, Elm Oyster)  
*Pluteus* sp. (free pink gills)  
*Polyporus alveolaris* (= *P. mori*, *Favolus alveolaris*; orange hexagonal pores)  
*Psathyrella* sp.  
*Pycnoporus cinnabarius* (Cinnabar Polypore)  
*Russula* spp. (Crumble Caps)  
*Scleroderma* cf. *areolatum* (Common Earthball; scaly peridium)  
*Scutellinia* cf. *umbrarum* (Eyelash Cup on wood)  
*Stereum complicatum* (Orange Parchment Fungus)  
*Stereum ostrea* (Common Parchment Fungus, False Turkey Tail)  
*Stereum hirsutum* (Hairy Parchment Fungus)

*Trametes elegans* (= *Daedaleopsis ambigua*; Ambiguous Polypore)

*Tremellodendron pallidum* (False Jelly Coral)
